



## READING SCHEMES

Reading schemes used at Kings Lodge School in Key Stage 1 and Foundation Stage classes.

At Kings Lodge School we use a variety of reading schemes in order to provide the breadth, depth and variety of reading books that will best develop our pupil's love of reading and their ability to become independent, reflective readers.

The main book scheme used is the new Pearson Bug Club, including Phonics Bug books, which were purchased in 2014-15, and stretches from new readers in FS to high Year 2 level interest. The scheme uses Interactive eBooks as well as reading resources, available online, to support parents at home with reading with their child.

This reading scheme is supplemented by OUP books that form part of the Oxford Reading Tree, Collins Big Cat Phonics and main scheme books, as well as Ginn All Aboard. Together with these texts, Kings Lodge uses Rigby Star group texts for Guided reading, as well as other sets of books from a range of publishers. This then ensure a breadth of reading resources to provide a balance of reading experience for our children.



As a school we have also recently introduced OUP's Project X Code books which form part of a reading intervention to those children who require additional support to reach the required level of reading. Project X continues into KS2. The feedback from the children is that they love these books!!
